

The Loft Cinema curates a comprehensive array of programs and events designed to serve the entire community. We have restarted most of our program that existed before the pandemic, and we have made some additions and changes to others. We're starting a series of Classic Hollywood Movies in 2023. We've also created Member Mondays starting in January 2023! We're also bringing back National Theatre Live and other performances captured live on HD to be seen on the big screen.

FILM PROGRAMS

FIRST-RUN FILMS

The best new independent, foreign and documentary films.

LOFT FILM FEST

The Loft Cinema's annual international film festival, presented by Desert Diamond Casinos & Entertainment and National Endowment for the Arts (see page 18 for more details).

LOFT KIDS FEST

An annual celebration of family-friendly films with an emphasis on underserved families, featuring an interactive program, hands-on activities, free admission and free popcorn (see page 22 for more details).

\$3 MEMBER MONDAYS (NEW!)

This is a new program starting in January 2023 to make all films all day every Monday \$3 for Loft Cinema Members!

ESSENTIAL CINEMA

A free series of the most iconic classic art films.

LATE NIGHT CULT CLASSICS

The greatest cult classics of all time on the big screen.

MONDO MONDAYS

A series of weird, wild and wonderful films from the Mondo side of the silver screen, every Monday night.

HOLLYWOOD CLASSICS (NEW!)

Experience the greatest films from Hollywood's Golden Age back on the big screen, every week at The Loft Cinema!

SPECIAL EVENTS

FIRST FRIDAY SHORTS

A monthly competition for local filmmakers to win \$200 and qualify for the finale in May, when the winners of all 12 months compete for \$1,000.

SCIENCE ON SCREEN

Thought-provoking films, paired with insightful contextual discussions with scientists to create illuminating and entertaining programming that brings the exciting world of science to life on the big screen. Made possible by a grant from the Alfred P. Sloan Foundation and the Coolidge Corner Theatre Foundation.

SHORTS PROGRAMS

The Loft Cinema gives audiences the rare opportunity to enjoy internationally-acclaimed short films on the big screen with annual screenings of nationally-touring shorts programs including the Oscar Nominated Short Films (Animated, Live Action and Documentary), the Sundance Film Festival Short Film Tour, the Manhattan Short Film Festival and Lunafest.

WHAT WE DO CONTINUED

GUEST FILMMAKERS

Industry professionals, including directors, producers, actors, and writers, interact with audiences and answer questions about the context and artistic content of their work.

LOCAL FILM PREMIERES

The Loft Cinema is the venue for premieres of films made in and around Tucson, or by Tucson-based filmmakers, often with the director, writer, producers, cast and crew in attendance.

SING-A-LONGS

The most beloved movie musicals of all time come to life at uniquely interactive events where the audience is the star! Onscreen lyrics bring all the songs to life, while prop-filled goodie bags, costume contests and other surprises help bring in the fun! Signature Loft Cinema Sing-A-Longs like *Grease, Purple Rain* and *The Very Merry Holiday Sing-A-Long Spectacular* have become annual Tucson traditions!

THE ALL-NITE SCREAM-O-RAMA

A 12 hour scream-errific cinematic slaughterhouse! Thrills and chills await audience members throughout the night with horror classics that are so scandalously shocking, the only way to stay alive is to keep repeating – "it's only a movie, it's only movie …"

THE SCI-FI SLUMBER PARTY

Sci-fi fans can buckle up for 12 straight hours of intergalactic excitement at the Sci-Fi Slumber Party!, a non-stop excursion into the outer limits of space age cinema, featuring more aliens, robots and apocalyptic insanity than you can shake a light saber at.

THE ROCKY HORROR PICTURE SHOW

The Loft Cinema has screened this cult phenomenon Saturdays at Midnight since 1977.

COMMUNITY

SOLAR CINEMA

Loft Solar Cinema is a cargo van outfitted with solar panels provided by our friends at Technicians for Sustainability. With the power of solar energy, Loft Solar Cinema projects films on a 20-foot inflatable screen using a state-of-the-art projector and sound system creating unique viewing experiences in underserved rural and urban areas, while indirectly promoting the value of sustainable energy. COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

The Loft Cinema collaborates with dozens of nonprofits and other organizations on screenings and events that allow the groups to promote the understanding of specific issues and to raise funds and awareness.

THEATER RENTALS

Rentals of the theatre are possible on Sundays and Tuesdays, pending availability. Nonprofit and independent filmmakers receive a 40% discount.

LOFT FILM FEST

For the 12th annual festival in 2022, The Loft Film Fest brought the world of cinema to Tucson with special guests, live performances and a curated selection of award-winning, buzz-worthy features, documentaries and short films from prestigious festivals around the globe, including Berlin, Cannes, Sundance, Toronto, Venice and more!

Loft Film Fest 2022 was a 100% in-person film festival, with 5157 patrons attending screenings and special events at The Loft Cinema, which features the largest traditional indoor movie screen in Southern Arizona.

The Loft Film Fest was once again presented by Desert Diamond Casinos & Entertainment and National Endowment for the Arts.

The opening night film and live music event featured the Tucson Premiere of the award-winning new animated time travel western set in Southern Arizona, **QUANTUM COWBOYS**, featuring a live music set on the Loft stage from Tucson-based celebrated musician **Howe Gelb**, who co-wrote the film and music score. Director **Geoff Marslett** and cast members **Gary Farmer, Wes Studi, Lily Gladstone**, and **Kiowa Gordon** were in attendance. **Quantum Cowboys** was the winner of the Best Original Music Award at the 2022 Annecy International Film Festival.

Gary Farmer presented the Lofty Achievement Award for his incredible body of work, which includes **Powwow Highway** (which was screened at the fest), **Smoke Signals, Dead Man** and the television series **Reservation Dogs**, which also features Wes Studi and Lily Gladstone.

Wes Studi, who received an Honorary Oscar in 2019, was also presented the Lofty Achievement Award for his body of work which includes **Last of the Mohicans** (which was screened at the fest), **Dances with Wolves, Heat** and **Avatar**.

JACQUELINE BISSET, the iconic star of such classic films as **Casino Royale** (1967), **Bullit** (1968), **Airport** (1970), **Murder on the Orient Express** (1974) and **Under the Volcano** (1984), was presented with the 2022 Lofty Achievement Award for her outstanding contributions to cinema, and appeared at screenings of her 1973 French film, **Day for Night** (directed by Francois Truffaut and winner of the 1974 Academy Award for Best Foreign Language Film), and her new film, **Loren & Rose**, the story of the indelible bond forged between an aspiring young filmmaker and a legendary actress. The director of **Loren & Rose**, **Russell Brown**, was also in attendance.

ANATOMY OF AN ARTHOUSE, a lively film journey through the past, present and future of The Loft Cinema, featuring interviews with the theatre's original 1972 founders, former and current key players, filmmaker guests and more. An ode to cinema and those who love it, as well as a fascinating look at the ever-evolving world of American arthouses, the documentary premiered at the 2022 Loft Film Fest as part of The Loft Cinema's year-long celebration of its golden 50th anniversary. Filmmakers **Mike Plante** and **Jason Willis**, along with many subjects from the film, attended this premiere screening.

The closing night film was **TRIANGLE OF SADNESS**, winner of the Palme D'Or at the 2022 Cannes Film Festival!

Our CICAE Art Cinema Award, selected by an esteemed panel of international jurors, was **Liquor Store Dreams**, a documentary by So Yum Um about the culture of Korean-owned liquor stores in black and brown neighborhoods in Los Angeles.













THE LOFT KIDS FEST RETURNED IN JULY 2022 FOR IN-PERSON FUN!

The annual Tucson summer tradition returned when LOFT KIDS FEST lit up The Loft Cinema for 11 days of free entertainment and excitement, every Saturday and Sunday morning in July!

Each day of the Fest, audiences experienced big screen presentations of some of the best family-friendly films of all-time, along with fun games, interactive activities, great giveaways, tons-o-free-popcorn, free prize raffles and more! Each screening also included a new animated short film from around the world! Daily pre-show activities were hosted by the staff of Mildred & Dildred Toy Store, and best of all, everything as always was FREE!

The Loft Cinema was excited to welcome Tucson families back to the theatre for all the movies, magic and fun of LOFT KIDS FEST 2022!

LOFT SOLAR CINEMA

The Loft Solar Cinema is a project that is crucial to fulfilling the Loft's mission. The concept is to take films to audiences, in urban neighborhoods and rural communities, for free, family friendly screenings.

The Loft Solar Cinema is a traveling project that uses a van outfitted with solar panels and batteries that power the 20-foot inflatable screen, the projector and sound system. The Loft partners with local stakeholders to curate films and events that are culturally relevant to each neighborhood and community.

After a record-setting year in 2019 with 35 screenings reaching more than 8000 people, Loft Solar Cinema went on hiatus, returning with a reduced schedule of screenings in the intervening years.


We expect Loft Solar Cinema to be back in full force in 2023, with the goal of serving even more communities and reaching more audiences!




The Loft Cinema, like movie theaters around the world, has experienced a dramatic drop in revenue and attendance as the world began to rebound from the pandemic. In 2021, The Loft joined many other venues – movies, theater, live music, museums, etc. – in accessing federal pandemic rescue funds, called Shuttered Venues Operating Grants (SVOG) equal to 45% of gross revenues in 2019, the last full year before the pandemic hit. This funding, along with the generosity of members, donors and patrons, helped keep The Loft Cinema open after a 14-month period of closure.


2021 REVENUE \$3,873,822


